Elected PCs unable to attend, assign your Proxy form via link below within your precinct. By submitting a proxy, you're recorded as "participating" per our PC Oath.

PC Services and Candidates available from 8 am – 9 am. Coffee, tea, water, donuts available. Badges, Merchandise, Trunk n' Tusk, PC Data Validation, and ALL Candidates' electioneering efforts are open from 8am - 9am ONLY in hallways and designated rooms outside of the Main PC Meeting room.

Closed County PC Meeting starts promptly at 9 am and runs until 12 noon. PCs please stay for entire meeting. Only the current YavGOP PCs (elected, waiting) and their limited preregistered county guests, as well as a few special guests for the [REDACTED], are allowed entry.

When registering, 2nd screen under "Meal Choice", please check if interested or not in breakfast from Gringo's, so we can give the vendor a headcount to plan meal supplies. PC Prewrite & Things to Know: Last day for Elected PCs to submit State Committeemen Application to be named on the ballot is Nov 18th via email to teriggirl@gmail.com. **Please come to the Statutory Meeting prepared!** Read the Meeting Rules, the proposed Bylaw Amendment and register for the meeting by Dec 8th. Elected PCs unable to attend should assign their YavGOP Proxy within your precinct. Per Bylaws 5.6.5 you may carry a max of two proxies for others in your precinct. Any floor nominations for Dec 10th for either an Officer or State Committeeman position must either: 1) Report to the Nominating Committee behind the Credentials desk to complete a Nominating Form by NO LATER THAN 9am; or 2) if you are unable to attend on Dec 10th, you must have submitted a letter stating your willingness to accept the floor nomination to the County Chair by Friday Dec 9th by 5pm (an email to countychair@ms.yavgorp.org is fine).
