

YAVGOP RESOLUTION 1002 – PROTECTION OF MINOR CHILDREN

The Yavapai County Republican Party demands the Protection of Minor Children in the State of Arizona.

WHEREAS Arizona Revised Statute (A.R.S.) Section 1-215 establishes that the age of majority is 18 years of age so minor children therefore cannot consent to sexual contact, or harmful, irreversible medical procedures; and A.R.S. Section 13-3553 prohibits the sexual exploitation of a minor; and A.R.S. Section 13-3506 prohibits knowingly and recklessly furnishing, presenting, providing, making available, giving, lending, showing, advertising or distributing to minors any item that is sexually inappropriate or harmful to minors; and A.R.S. Section 13-3558 prohibits admitting minors to public displays of sexual conduct;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Yavapai County Republican Party

- (1) Condemns any surgery on a minor that
 - a. results in sterilization of said minor
 - b. artificially constructs tissue with the appearance of genitalia
 - c. is a mastectomy or removal of any otherwise healthy body part or tissue;
- (2) Condemns the prescription, dispensation, administration or other supply to minors of puberty-blocking medication, or supraphysiologic doses of testosterone to females or estrogen to males;
- (3) Supports the criminalization of irreversible medical treatments performed on minors for the purpose of changing perceived gender, to include loss of violators' professional license(s); and,
- (4) Supports adding permitting sexual reassignment of a minor to the definition of an abused child in the "National Child Protection Act of 1993"; and,
- (5) Supports parents' right to know if their child has the perception that his or her gender is inconsistent with his or her genetic sex; and
- (6) Supports imposition of felony criminal penalties for violations of A.R.S. statutes listed in the first paragraph and extending legislation to prohibit any adult from taking a minor to a drag show, strip club, or sex show.
