Approved Resolution, September 14, 2024

Electoral power of the citizens of the USA is being diminished by illegal aliens.

The Biden/Harris administration is actively trying to subvert the voter rights of the citizens of the United States of America, We The People.

Whereas the Biden/Harris administration took numerous executive actions to open the border to illegal immigration, and

Whereas since Biden/Harris took office 11 to 22 million illegal aliens have entered the USA, many of whom are on the terror watch list or known criminals, and

Whereas illegal aliens are counted in the census and congressional seats are assigned based on the census, and

Whereas there are currently more illegal aliens in the United States than the population of Arizona, and

Whereas the Biden/Harris administration actively opposed the Save Act which would have prevented illegal aliens from voting in our elections, and

Whereas numerous Democrats, including Kamala Harris, have advocated for citizenship and voting rights for illegal aliens, and

Whereas "All political power is inherent in the people..." (Article 2, Section 2 Arizona State Constitution), and

Whereas "The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged..." (15th amendment U.S. Constitution).

Therefore be it resolved that the Yavapai County Republican Committee:

1. Calls on the Biden/Harris administration to reverse any executive actions which facilitate illegal aliens crossing the border, and
2. Calls on the Biden/Harris administration to close the border, and
3. Calls on the US Senate and Joe Biden to pass the Save Act to ensure only U.S. citizens can vote in our elections, and
